

Proposed Shoal Creek and Maplewoods Parkway Loop



Construction Priority: Second

This 14.09 mile, off-road, hard surface, shared use trail allows the user to experience internal and external feature components of Hodge Park. From the intersection of Shoal Creek and Maplewoods Parkways the user travels south across highway 152 and through the northeast corner of Gladstone. From here the trail turns north

and eventually enters Hodge Park where the user passes the Shoal Creek Missouri Historic Site to the west and Hodge Park Golf Course on the east. Continue along Shoal Creek Parkway to 96th street where the radio controlled airfield is located and west to arrive back at the point of beginning.
