Construction Priority: Second

This 11.96-mile, off-road, hard surface, shared use trail to be constructed in conjunction with Tiffany Springs Parkway begins at N Highway and ends at Maplewoods Parkway. The user begins the route near the Historic Military Trail site and travels east to Tiffany Springs Park. The user will cross Prairie View Road near The

Tiffany Greens Golf Course. From here the route across the Platte/Clay County line to the Maplewoods Parkway where access to Smithville Lake, Liberty and the rest of Clay County is made possible.
