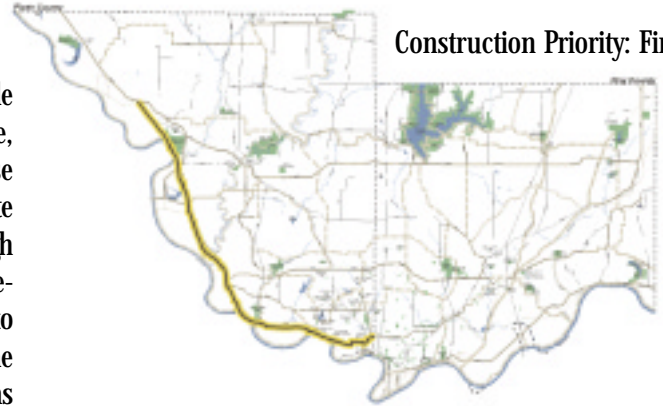


Riverside-Weston Route



The first leg of this 26.42-mile route consists of an 8.15 mile, off road, hard surface shared use trail. It begins at the Clay/Platte County line and travels through Riverside and winds within eyesight of the Missouri River up to historic Weston. In Riverside, the

Argosy Casino is nearby and as you travel west Park College looms large on the hillside. Stop in the wonderfully renovated downtown area of Parkville or visit the Parkville Nature Sanctuary before heading north. At Helen Parma Park this trail changes to a on-road, hard surface, paved shoulder that extends 13.89 miles parallel to the BNSF Railroad through floodplain area leading to the town of Farley



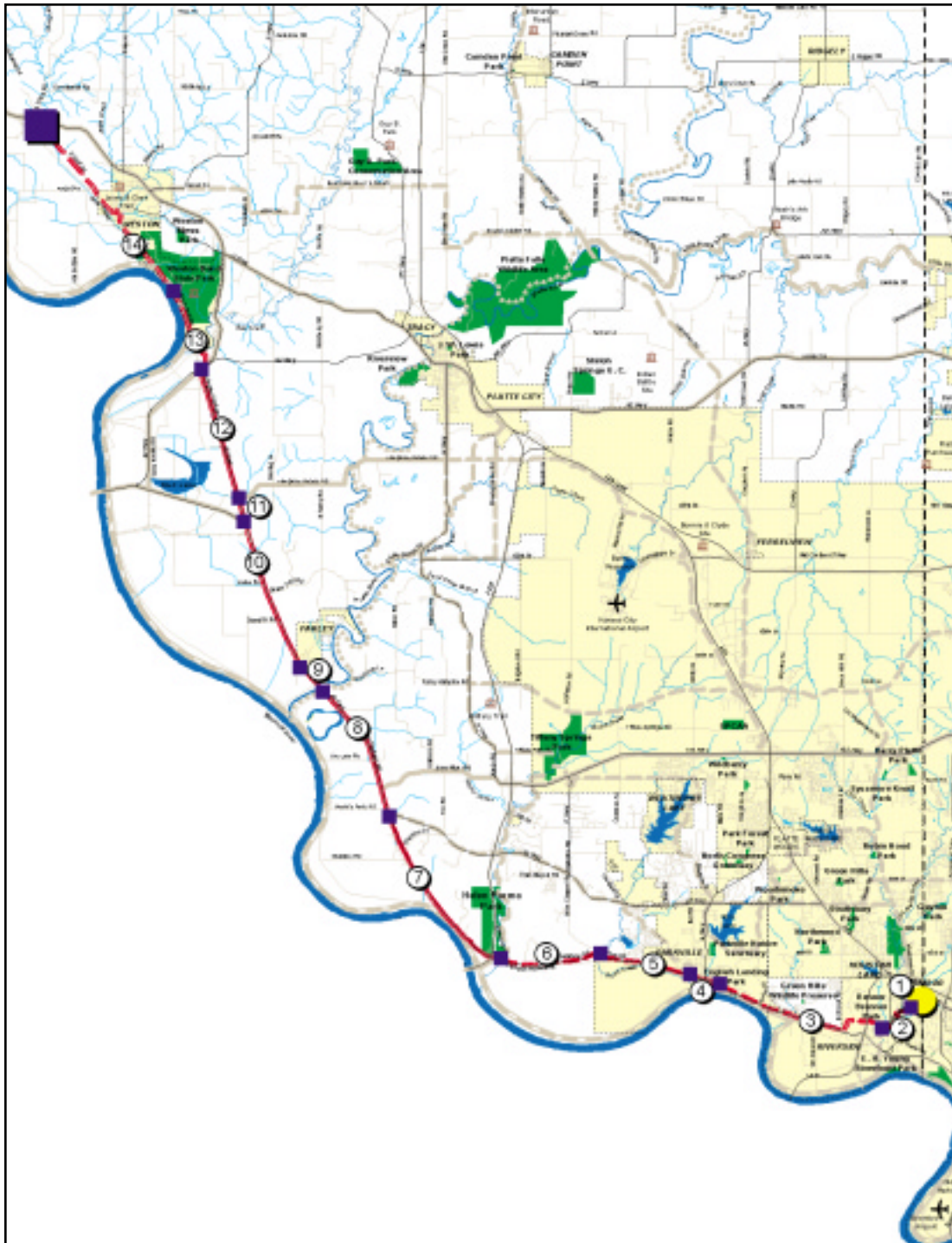
Construction Priority: First

and historic Weston. Trail users will be able to view Ft. Leavenworth on the west bank of the Missouri River in the distance; Once the trail user reaches Weston Bend State Park the trail transitions to an on-road, soft surface shared use trail that extends 5.0 miles to Highway 45.
